

## **FCC Paperless Amateur Radio License Policy Goes into Effect on February 17<sup>th</sup>**

**FCC says that applicants or licensees who include a valid E-mail address under “Application Information” in the ULS will receive an official electronic authorization via E-mail. New license applications who do not provide a FCC registration number at the examination point will receive a printed license as well as a FRN and a temporary password to access the Commission Registration System.
