So go through your file and bring your oldest card and, if you have one, a card from a rare country or a country no longer in existence.

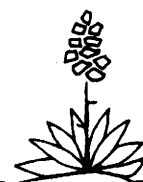
A MESSAGE FROM OUR EMERGENCY SERVICE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN:

HAM GAB-

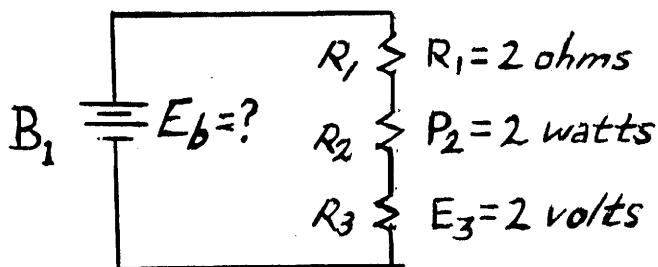
