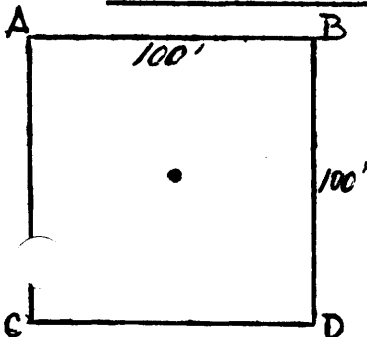
QSL SERVICE- ARRL membership overseas QSL service is being streamlined. See QST, May '79, P.68
