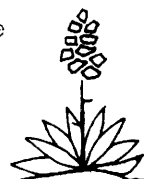

Proposed amendments to the Constitution of The Sun City Amateur Radio Club, Inc.

Following are the amendments to the Constitution of the Club being proposed and to be presented to the membership at the September 18 regular meeting. In accordance with the Constitution they will be voted upon at the next following regular meeting. They all fall under Article V. of the Constitution, which deals with the subject of Committees.

Sec. 8- The duties of the RFI Committee shall parallel those of the TVI committee, except that they shall deal with the problem of interference to radio broadcast and other electronic reproduction caused by the operation of amateur radio stations.

Sec. 9- The Social Committee shall be responsible for organizing special events of the Club, such as picnics, anniversaries, "ladies' night" parties, etc., including advance ticket sales, catering and entertainment.

Sec.10- The Publicity Committee shall maintain contact with Sun City radio broadcast stations and newspapers and shall submit to them information on Club activities for publication through such channels.

Sec.11- The Emergency Service Committee shall organize members of the Club into operating communication units for emergency service during any interruption of normal channels of public communication as a result of storms, floods, explosions, etc. Advance training programs shall be sponsored so as to assure the proper operation of equipment.

Sec.12- The ARRL Liaison Committee shall be responsible for bringing to the attention of Club members such revisions in operating rules ordered by the Federal Communication Commission. It shall maintain a record of expiration of the ARRL membership of its members so that the Club may obtain its allotted portion of the annual ARRL dues of its members.

Sec.13- The Silent Key Committee shall represent the Club at the local funerals of its deceased members, shall notify the Club officers concerning the death of any members and shall offer to the family assistance in the disposition of the radio equipment of the deceased member.

Sec.14- The "Short Skip" Editor shall turn over to the Club Secretary news items concerning Club activities, local hamfests and such other items as may be of interest to the members, for publication in the Club bulletin.

Sec.15- The Service Awards Committee shall observe the performance of Club officers, committee chairmen and Club members and shall recommend to the Club President the names of those whom the Committee may deem worthy of recognition for their service,- presentation of suitable awards for such meritorious service to be made at the December regular meeting of each year.

Sec.16- The Constitution and By-laws Committee shall be responsible for making suggestions additions and revisions to the Club Constitution and By-laws as they may deem desirable for the operation and welfare of the Club.

Addition to Section 6- The Nominating Committee shall be appointed in February of each calendar year.
