1. FCC has made permanent the regulation (formerly temporary) making the 424-450 MHz band available to location equipment.
2. The Commission has denied permission for F2 on the 1.82 MHz band.
3. FCC has denied a proposal to authorize non-hams to operate radio-controlled model boats and planes on the amateur bands.
