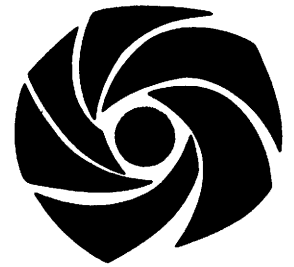

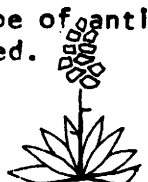
The Arizona QSO Party is scheduled for Feb. 5-6, '83. Contact Jim, K7DI, for a flyer on details.
